Quick Start Guide

1 Download the Palace Project App on the Apple App Store for IOS phones & tablets or the Google Play Store for Android phones & tablets.



2 Open the Palace app, tap “Find Your Library,” & type or scroll to find Mountain Regional Library System to access the collection of ebooks and audiobooks.

3 Browse available titles by selecting any of the headings to view additional or related titles. Or, search for a specific title by selecting the the magnifying glass in the upper right corner of the screen.

4 Select the desired title and tap “Get.” If your book is currently unavailable, tap “Reserve” to place a hold. After choosing to get or reserve a title, you will be prompted to sign in with your library card number & pin. Enter the numbers with no spaces in between.

5 Once your book has been downloaded, tap “Read” or “Listen” & enjoy! Borrowed titles can be easily accessed by selecting “My Books” at the bottom of the screen.
